## **Nurse Practitioner (RN-EC)**

NPs function as the Most-Responsible Provider (MRP) for a defined roster of patients. The NP will collaborate internally with registered nurse, registered dietitian, social worker and occupational therapist colleagues, and externally with specialist physicians and community services and agencies in the provision of primary health care for their patients. You will practice autonomously, providing periodic health examinations, pharmacological and counseling interventions, health promotion, and chronic disease management.

Ours is an environment where everyone works interdependently towards common goals. While we operate in a MRP model, support is always provided, both formally and informally, so you are never truly alone in providing care and where you are able to leverage the expertise of your colleagues.
